- **Bildungsroman**-a story that is about events and experiences in the life of the main character as they grow up and become an adult:

 Independent newspaper as one of the 100 most influential LGBT people in the United Kingdom. His poetry
 often deals with questions of identity and social justice.

Key symbols/motifs

Flamingo -a symbol of difference, flamboyance, uniqueness, nurture, acceptance, Michael's perception of himself **Black Flamingo** - a symbol of transformation, drag identity, acceptance and celebration, pride, difference

Childhood objects - *Barbie*: a symbol of gender assumptions, ideas about femininity and glamour *Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles*: as a symbol of masculine assumptions, *The Pink Flamingo*: a symbol of difference, *Telescope*: family connection, escape

Locations - Stage- symbol of Michael's transformation, Michael's identity as a performer Brighton- university, gay identity, pebble beach as a symbol of difference and non-conformity Greece- a symbol of, family, identity(Greek), race Names - a symbol of the different parts of Michael's identity, different stages of his life, a symbol for his inspirations and mentors a symbol of new beginnings/identities, symbols of gender: Surname University, drag names, Bob Marley, Greek names

Drag - a symbol of transformation, identity, acceptance, pride, links to Halloween costume, a symbol of belonging and communication

Locs - a symbol of Michael's Jamaican side, a symbol of prejudice, identity, assumptions and stereotypes, links to Medusa, symbol of transformation
